Following a successful launch in 2006, the global professional standards initiative IP3 (see http://www.ipthree.org/) has made some significant progress. The IP3 Board has finalized a formal three year strategic and operational Business Plan. Its implementation is managed by CIPS member Roger Hart, I.S.P., ITCP/IP3P, who has been appointed Interim Executive Officer, and former CIPS Chair Greg Lane, I.S.P., ITCP/IP3P, who currently chairs the IP3 Board. The IP3 Board formal terms of reference were approved in principle and will be submitted to the IFIP General Assembly meeting in August for inclusion in the IFIP Standing Orders, which defines the operating rules for IFIP related bodies.
