National Study Reveals Metrics on HI and HIM Labour and Skills Shortages

Partners Stress the Immediate Need for a Human Resource Strategy

A landmark economic study, Health Informatics and Health Information Management - Human Resources Report, identifies a serious need for increased labour and skills among Canadian Health Information (HI) and Health Information Management (HIM) professionals over the next five years. Key findings in the report, presented during the Fall 2009 Infoway Partnership Conference, are:

- Approximately 32,450 HI and HIM professionals are currently working in Canada.
- An additional 6,320 to 12,330 HI and HIM professionals are needed by 2014, primarily due to the growing investment and adoption of electronic health information systems (EHIS)
- Current vacancy rates of over 10 per cent exist for six of the 27 occupational groups studied.
- HI and HIM professionals who require broader skills will increase from 8,880 in 2009 to between 13,690 and 32,170 by 2014.
